New items needed throughout the year for Blackburn Center's clients/shelter residents.

Kitchen

Pots & saucepan sets

Small appliances: microwaves, crock-pots, air fryers, etc.

Zip-lock bags—2.5 gallon size only

Not needed at this time: toasters, coffee pots, mixers

***Food items we especially need include: single-serving shelf-stable items, cans or pouches of cooked meat/fish, canned soups, microwavable shelf-stable meals, juice boxes, shelf-stable milk, sugar, powdered coffee creamer, and all condiments. We can only accept donations of non-perishable goods.**
